

Most recent abuse of Jennifer Emmi

July 13, 2022 – Jennifer saw Dr. Creany. He's the internist that works at DOC. Jennifer was short of breath, having chest pain and was sweating. He said he would get in touch with Dr. Randolph Maul and have her admitted to Rose Hospital under the care of D. Kung, (Jennifer's private neurologist). The clinic ran out of Jennifer's heart medication, Metoprolol. She also hadn't had her Eliquis for several days. The warden, Ryan Long said he would see her, he made an appointment but never showed up. Jennifer was never sent to Rose Hospital and her symptoms were never addressed.

July 14, 2020 – Jennifer went to the clinic exhibiting symptoms of a pulmonary embolism. She had a history of four other PE's so she was aware of the symptoms. She had extreme chest pain, she was sweating profusely, short of breath and was tachycardic. She begged Nurse Richard to send her to the hospital telling him she knew she had an embolism. He told her to stop being so dramatic and pushed her in a room alone. She apparently passed out and was awakened some time later by her OCA, CeAnn Garza who found her undressed and lying there exposed. Jennifer was upset because she thought her nurse left her like that after drawing blood from the port in her chest. Bella wanted to send the blood out for a D-Dimer, (a test to confirm a PE), but the HSA, Nicole Price would not allow it. She obviously didn't want proof of the embolism that was ignored. The only other person in the clinic was a guard named Michael Beechley who never bothered to turn his head while she was being redressed. Her OCA helped her redress and took her back to her cell. Jennifer later saw her nurse, Bella and asked her why she left her undressed with that guard watching her. Bella assured her she was completely redressed and covered when she left her. Jennifer asked CeAnn to write a statement regarding what she saw. CeAnn gladly wrote it and signed it.

August 17, 2022 – Jill Coit and Bessie Phillips, (both inmates) came to Jennifer and said they saw on the news that Jennifer Emmi was sexually assaulted. Jennifer had no idea how the news media would have found out but that's when the abuse escalated. I have no idea either. Leisha Connor is a RN at the prison and is

a witness to Jennifer's sexual assault and did a vaginal swab to rule out any STD's. She said she would be a witness to the assault.

August 21, 2022 – Jennifer got permission to go to her Braille lesson that she had been going to since November 2021. The lessons were taught by Jill Coit. When she arrived, she was stopped by Deputy Rivera and cited for leaving her unit. She was told she would have to go to a hearing. Jill Coit was threatened to lie about giving her lessons for the past 9 months.

September 23, 2022 – Jennifer approached Michael Beechly asking him what he did to her and why he undressed her. She had been bleeding since the assault which was witnessed by Guard AK and Guard Martinez. They were upset and reported the constant bleeding to medical, the warden and Jennifer's case manager. AK was very upset that she was still bleeding and nothing was being done. Lynn Jesik told Jennifer that she should have collected her own forensic evidence and did nothing. Jennifer thought she was going to the hospital but instead was put in closed custody. Jennifer has cracked and bleeding fingertips which are very painful. This is a side effect of LUPUS. It's was hard to pull on the stiff green uniform pants so Jennifer had on sweat pants. Other inmates wore sweat pants as well, but Jennifer got cited for it by Wendy Checkush, Kathy Mentas and Wendy Contes.

November 11, 2022 – Jennifer was unable to push her wheelchair back to her cell so Wendy Contes had her handcuffed and shackled to her wheelchair. She did nothing to cause this and the inmate were screaming from their cells to leave her alone. They refused to allow her OCA to help her. This was a malicious use of force causing injury to her wrists. Jennifer was locked in her cell and not given food, water and her medications for over 24 hours. Inmates Sosha Flores, Sarah Pring and Romona Benevidez got inmates to sign statements about the abuse Jennifer was receiving but Guard found the statements that were signed and ripped it up. Romona Benevidez and Angelique Lopez are both willing to be a witness to the abuse.

January 5, 2023 – Jennifer was on the phone talking to her attorney when a fire drill occurred. Jennifer was unable to get to her cell alone and Guard Tarin got her wheelchair, pulled it back and pushed it in her cell as hard as he could causing it to crash against the wall and almost throwing her out of her chair. Her thumb

got dislocated and it broke her watch. She is still complaining of shoulder and neck pain from the whiplash. The incident even left marks on her cell floor. She had to remain in her cell for over 24 hours without food, water and her medications. When the inmates were allowed outside, Guard Tarin asked Jennifer, "how are you enjoying the sunshine?" Jennifer was in pain and was asking to go to medical. Guard Wood said, "Shut the fuck up".

January 8, 2023 – Jennifer was going to the chow hall by her OCA. Her thumb was very painful so Jennifer left her sweat pants on. Guard Earl came over to Jennifer and very roughly, put a handcuff on her right wrist and began swinging her around like a rag doll. Jenny Nyghen (not sure of spelling) witnessed Guard out of control. He was even told by other guards to calm down. Jennifer is now left with a bruised wrist that is extremely painful.

January 11, 2023 – She was taken to see Dr. Creany. He had no idea about her consultation with the pulmonologist, or any of her care. His whole demeanor changed with him. Jennifer wanted a witness in with her because he promises one thing and does something else. He asked Jennifer's Nurse Katie to leave the room and began to tell her that her split and bleeding fingers were not from LUPUS and in fact, she doesn't have LUPUS. He was extremely inappropriate and threatening. She asked him for physical therapy to rebuild the strength in her legs. He changed and discontinued some of her medications, he decreased her ADA status and threw a blanket in her face. He then pushed her out of the room accusing her of threatening him. The guard took her back to her cell and took her wheelchair away.

January 12, 2023 – The inmates put Jennifer on a chair and pushed her to the phone. While there, guard Nesmith and Kathy Mestas grabbed Jennifer and put her in the Hannibal Lecter chair strapping her in. The inmates were all yelling to leave her alone. Guard Graham actually had tears in his or her eyes watching this. They then put Jennifer in the hole where she remains. They only give her medications or her food if she can get to the door to take it. If and when she can't, they leave and she gets nothing. They also threw away some of her personal items. Only the things that meant the most to her.

Jennifer is meticulous and writes everything down. She knows dates and times of everything.
